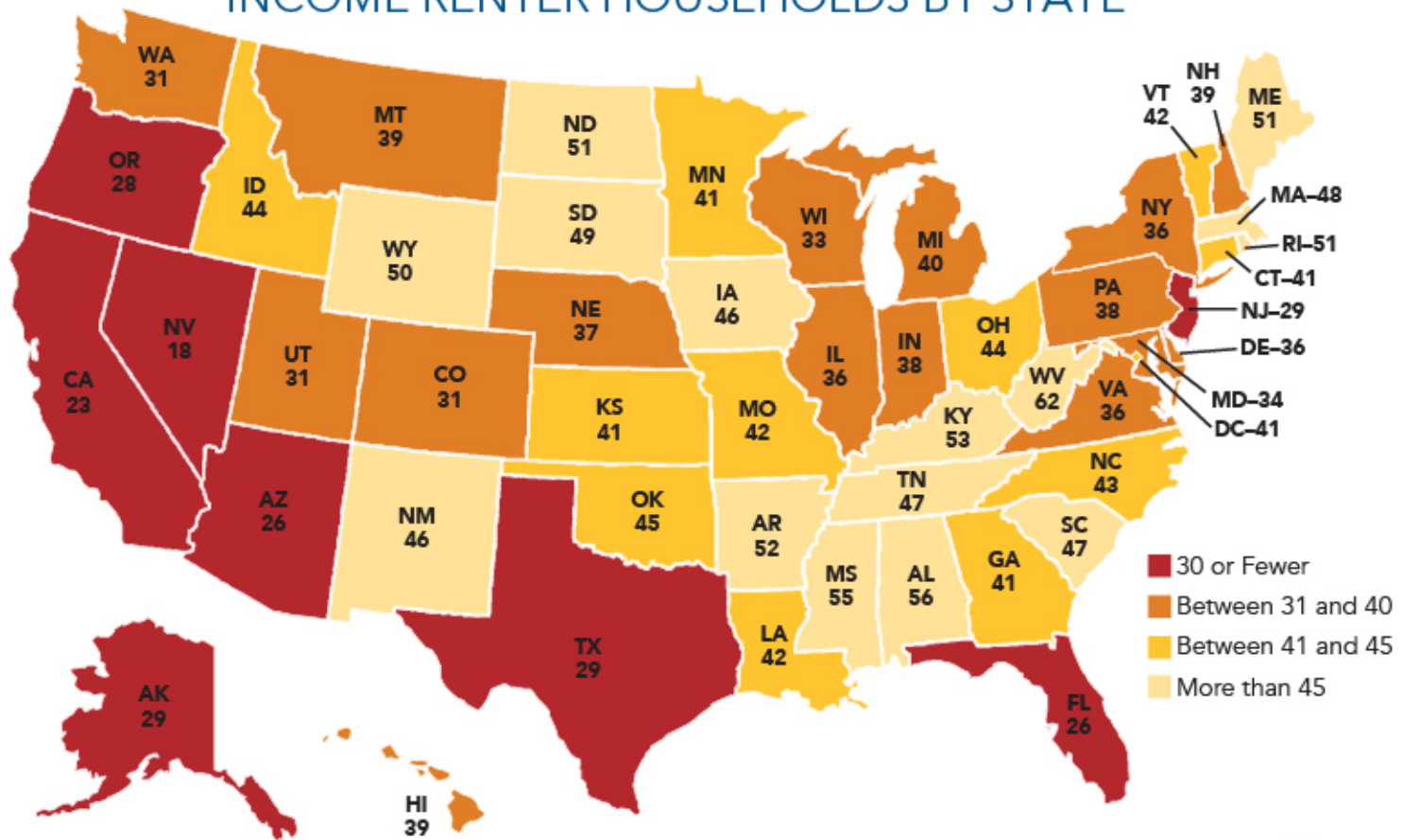

Weekly initial unemployment claims in 2020

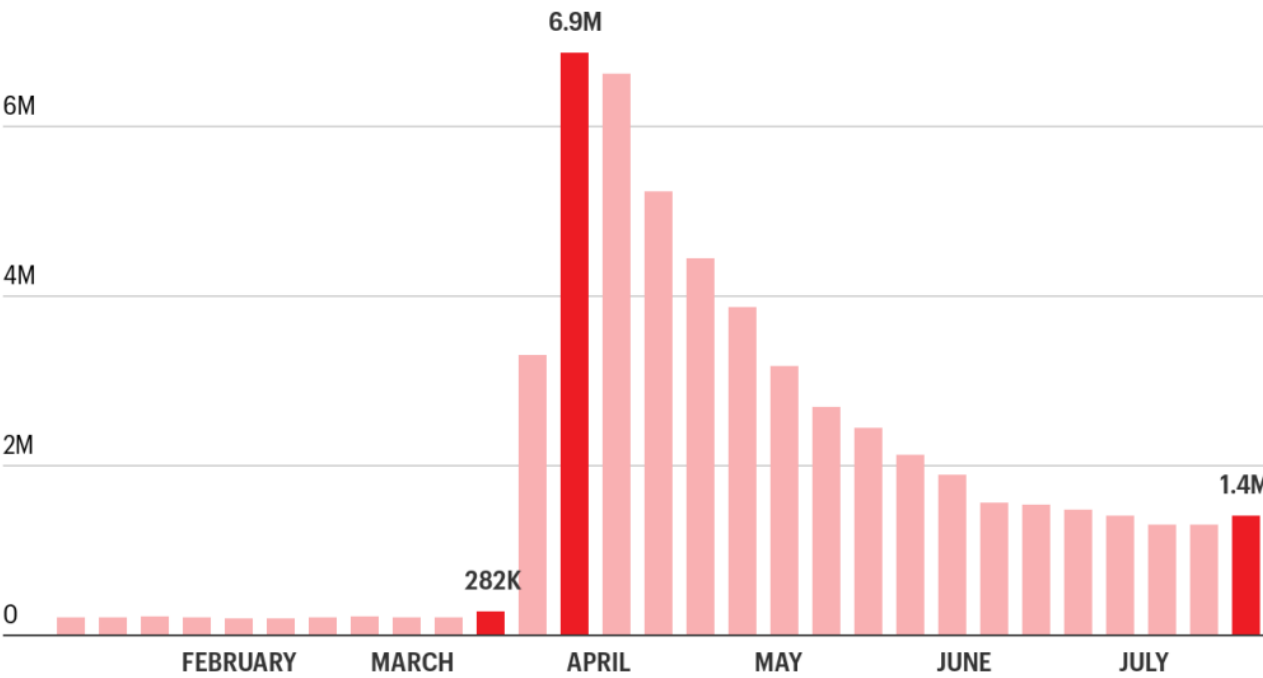


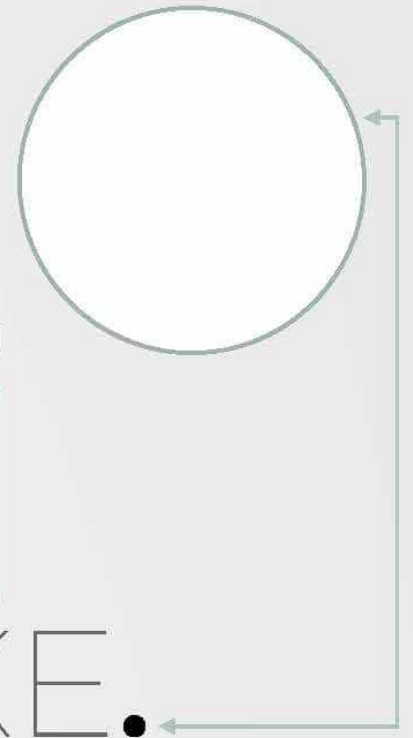

CARES Act

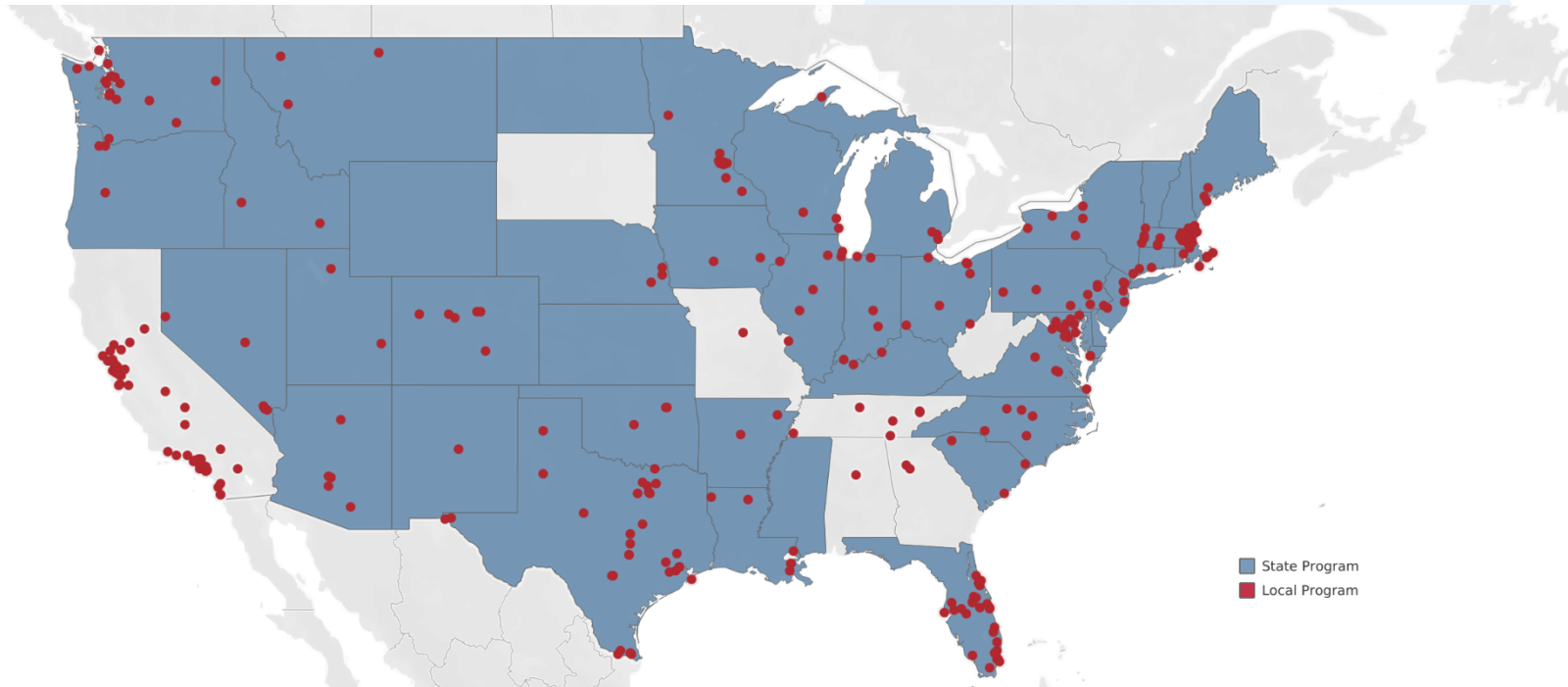


- **Emergency Solutions Grants: \$4B**
- **Community Development Block Grants: \$5B**
- **HUD subsidized renters: \$3B**
- **Coronavirus Relief Fund: \$150 billion**
- **Limited Federal Eviction and Foreclosure Moratoriums**

Now:

- Patchwork of state/local eviction moratoriums expiring, federal eviction moratorium expires Dec. 31.
- Renters owe tens of billions in rent arrears

Urgently Needed Action



- National, uniform moratorium on evictions
- Emergency rental assistance and eviction prevention: \$100 billion
- Emergency Solutions Grants: At least \$11.5 billion



In the meantime...



- Get the word out on the CDC Eviction Moratorium
- Governors and Mayors: establish state/city eviction moratoriums
- Spend all available funds for emergency rental assistance!
- Target limited resources to those with the greatest/most urgent needs
